

Lincoln P. Bloomfield, Jr. founded Palmer Coates LLC in 2005. His education and professional career have centered on international affairs, including foreign policy and defense. A graduate of Harvard College (*a.b. cum laude*, 1974) and the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy (M.A.L.D., 1980) where he was Director of *The Fletcher Forum*, the school's foreign affairs journal, he has served in an appointed capacity in the past five republican administrations.

Mr. Bloomfield was appointed by President Bush to be the U.S. Special Envoy for MANPADS Threat Reduction from 2008-09 with the rank of Ambassador. From 2001-2005 he was U.S. Assistant Secretary of State for Political Military Affairs, also serving as Special Representative of the President and Secretary of State for Humanitarian Mine Action. He previously served as Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern Affairs (1992-93), Deputy Assistant to the Vice President for National Security Affairs (1991-02), and Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for International Security Affairs (1988-89). He was a member of the US water mediation between Israel and Jordan in 1990, and a member of the US delegation negotiating the future of US facilities in the Philippines in 1991-92. In eight years as a Defense Department official beginning in 1981, Mr. Bloomfield served as Country Director for Lebanon (1982-85) and Country Director for Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam and Burma (1985-86) among other policy responsibilities. His first government role was as an intern at the Congressional Research Service, Foreign Affairs and National Defense division, in 1979.

Current *pro bono* affiliations include as a Director and National Executive Committee Member of the U.S. Water Partnership; as a Director of the non-profit energy projects entity The Last Kilometer; and as a principal in the non-profit energy advisory Net Zero Advisors. He is Chairman Emeritus and Distinguished Fellow at the non-partisan Stimson Center, the Washington, DC security think tank whose Board he chaired from 2008-2016. Previously he was a founding board member of Landmine Survivors Network (later renamed Survivor Corps).

Current commercial affiliations include service since 2005 as non-Attorney Consultant - Senior Advisor to Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, Strategic Advisor to Seatrec, Inc., Co-Founder and Chief Strategy Officer of D3 Express, Senior Advisor to Last Kilometer Solutions LLC; and as a Policy Advisor with Strategic Advisory Solutions International (SASI-DC). Previous business affiliations include serving as a partner with Armitage Associates L.C. (1993-2001), Chairman of Bell Pottinger Communications USA LLC, Operating Advisor with Pegasus Capital Advisors L.C. (2008-2016), and Senior Advisor to ZeroBase Energy LLC (2009-2016). Palmer Coates LLC has provided services to many companies since 2005.
